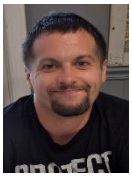

Hi, my name is **Justin Finley** and I am 33 years old. I was raised by my grandparents, which is a decision my mother made due to her addiction. I was raised in church and taught right from wrong. Whenever I visited my mother, I would get molested by her boyfriend. This led to anger and depression. I was bullied to the point where I had to change schools. I started to hang out with the wrong crowd, they accepted me with open arms. They introduced me to witchcraft at the age of 13 and by the age of 16, I was living a homosexual lifestyle and quit school. At the age of 17, I was selling myself for crack cocaine and meth. I was so far in the darkness I didn't think there was any way out. My grandmother passed away when I was 22 which drove me further into my addiction. I felt hopeless. I woke up one day tired of it all so reached out for help, but I kept going back to my mess. I couldn't do it on my own. Finally, I called out to Jesus and He answered me. Jesus led me to Freedom House. Since coming here things have not been easy. After a month I decided to leave. I had all the things of the world but there was still a void in my life. We haven't finished phase 1 or the 4-phase remodel project!! We are so excited to be moving forward. The next phase will be a total rehab of the Open Door Church children's bldg. We have been given total use of this building now and will begin to remodel to house 14 resident's women and 10 women staff. We will start this project October 1, 2024. The remodel will consist of installing showers and laundry facilities, moving walls, building a kitchenette, replacing all light fixtures, re-wiring, painting and new flooring. Once the construction is complete, we will also need 24 memory foam mattresses, 12 sets of heavy-duty metal bunk bed frames, bedding, pillows, dressers and rugs. We will need financial help as well as manpower to make this happen.
